SQAS, a Cefic initiative, is a voluntary assessment system that evaluates the safety, environmental, security, health, and quality, performance of logistics service providers, including road and rail carriers, tank cleaning stations, and warehouses. Assessments are conducted by accredited SQAS Assessors.

What can you expect from this Cefic training?

- A uniform and consistent interpretation of assessment questionnaires and guidelines by all assessors, regardless of their background or country;
- A common assessment standard amongst assessors concerning legislative requirements and the industry standards related to safety, health, environment, security, quality and corporate social responsibility (CSR) aspects of these partner industries;
- An accreditation to carry out SQAS audits in a certain territory (typically one or two countries)

The training will take place in person in Brussels. The venue will be communicated to the registered participants in due time. Participation in this training is complimentary and subject to confirmation of registration.
